Trail Talk: Safety & Info

Let’s take a moment to talk about what you should have with you when driving an ATV in Ontario:

- Valid Driver’s Licence (Original)
 - Required under Ontario ORVA/MTO rules when operating an ATV/ORV on public land, including Simcoe County Forest trails)
- Proof of Insurance
- Vehicle Registration (Original, if copy front and back must be legible)
- Valid Trail Permit (Mounted on the ATV or SxS, if on the phone take screen shot with date visible)
